

## Micro Soccer FAQ

What time of the day are typical practices?

Generally practices are Monday, Wednesday or Fridays at 4 or 5 pm. Practice times depend on your coach. In August, we send out a schedule request from coaches to get their practice preference day and time. It is assigned on a 1st come 1st served basis.

When are games played?

Last year, games were played on Sundays. This will probably be the case again this year due to field shortage in West Bellevue.

What is the maximum number of players that you can have on a team?

We are only allowed to have 6 players on a team.

Please note your requests when you register. Teams are placed based on registration date and school. We do our best to satisfy all requests, but we do not guarantee team placement.

When will I know what team my child is on?

Generally we send out rosters by the beginning of August. Your coach will contact you.
